Are you interested in expanding your network with fellow students from other universities?

If your answer to the questions above is 'yes!', we invite you to join the World Class The Hague program! An initiative of the City of The Hague, the World Class is an informative one-year program during which you will attend lectures from inspiring speakers and learn what The Hague has to offer as the global leader in the domain of Peace & Justice.



### The Hague: International City of Peace and Justice

The Hague is known as the international city of Peace & Justice. The city is home to many international organizations, including the International Criminal Court, the International Court of Justice, OPCW, Europol and NGOs such as UNICEF and Oxfam Novib. Attending the World Class provides you with the opportunity to attend lectures from reputable speakers from such organizations and to expand your knowledge about the peace and justice ecosystem.

## What is the World Class program?

The World Class program constitutes two parts: the World Class lectures and Xtra events.

The World Class lectures are a series of inspiring talks organized with high-profile national and international speakers. Every lecture will reflect on the theme of Peace and Global Justice from a different perspective. The lectures will take place in the evening on different locations in The Hague.

The Xtra events are more informal social activities which enable you to immerse yourself in the field of peace and global justice in an accessible way. Xtra events include guided tours, access to interesting events or an informal debate. These Xtra events usually take place with a smaller group of students and are organized on a first come, first serve basis.



- The World Class is the perfect opportunity to expand your knowledge on the topics related to peace, justice and international relations and to learn how the Hague is committed to create a more just and safer world. You gain this information first-hand by attending lectures from inspiring and high-profile leaders in the global community!
- Expand your network and connect with fellow students with similar interests. Every World Class event starts or finishes with an informal get together, allowing you to get to know each other and to meet with peers from different backgrounds.
- Upon completion of the program you will receive a certificate for your participation, signed by the Mayor of The Haque.
- Last but not least, it is a lot of fun to attend the program and to meet new people!







#### Registration

Registration is open for students of the following institutions: Leiden University (Campus The Hague), The Hague University of Applied Sciences, Inholland University of Applied Sciences
The Hague, International Institute of Social Studies (ISS) and Delft University of Technology. Students from any study programme, background and nationality are very welcome to apply. To sign up for the World Class program, please send an email to <a href="worldclass@denhaag.nl">worldclass@denhaag.nl</a> along with a motivation letter (approximately 200 – 300 words) why you want to join the program. A maximum of 100 students can participate in the World Class program, so register now! The deadline for registration is 30 September 2022.

#### **Useful information**

- The World Class starts in October 2022 and ends in June 2023. On average, one World Class event per month is hosted
- Attendance of the World Class lectures is mandatory. If you
  attend three or more of the World Classes, you will receive a
  certificate for your participation. If you miss more than one
  World Class without letting us know, your spot will be made
  available to another student.
- World Class lectures are hosted in the evening on weekdays at a location in The Hague (as long as the COVID regulations allow). Lectures are followed by networking drinks.
- Attendance of the World Class is free of charge.



- Even though the World Class program lasts just one year, you
  will be kept informed on World Class activities beyond 2023
  as you will be added to the alumni network.
